

UK Printmaking to be Exhibited in Hunan

The "Intersecting Practices of Contemporary Printmaking in the UK" will be exhibited at Changsha Municipal Museum in April, 2016.

Co-hosted by Carpe Diem Arts Studio and the Department of Printmaking of China Academy of Art, the exhibition made its debut in Hangzhou last September. It included works by 28 British artists such as a printmaking teacher from the Royal College of Art, to showcase the versatile art of contemporary printmaking in the UK.

Besides British printmaking, Hunan printmakers' masterpieces will be displayed at the exhibition in Changsha.

Exhibition curator Zhoujian, a Hunan-born artist, founded the Carpe Diem Arts Studio in Britain in 2015. Zhou hoped that the exhibition will deepen cultural exchange between China and Britain while promoting Huxiang culture to the world.
