


#### Feminism designs with others in mind: race, gender, language, class, (dis)ability, culture...






#### Feminism teaches Activism Disruption Radicalism








## Feminism takes a critical position

#### Feminism concerns designing beyond the gender binary








#### Feminism teaches ethics
