FILM PREMIERE
BEFORE A FASHION
Originating from observations of fashion design students and their learning methods at Central Saint Martins, the short film BEFORE A FASHION explores the performed relationships between the body, materials and the act of creating. It interrogates fashion terminologies such as 'manner' and 'style', and how these inform how we stand, sit or move and capture the Zeitgeist of the time.
